2. Putao Children Teachers Seminar

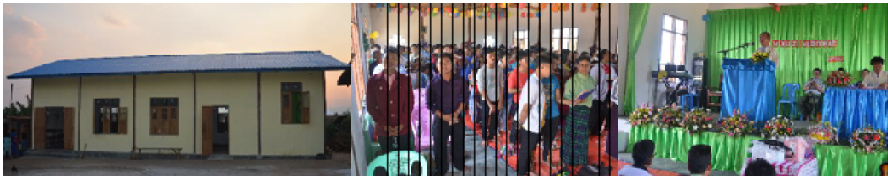

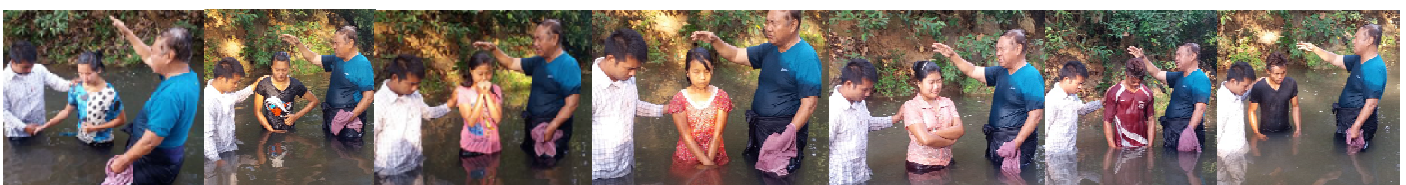

Now I am happy because I am free from reciting the Buddhish scriptures. Instead, I can read the Bible.

Taking being poor of the parents as an advantage, the Buddhists are attracting the children of the Lisu ancestor worshipers with the help of schooling. Therefore, helping the children of the new converts become an urgent need. So, this year, Philip and his wife are helping 15 children schooling and Manasseh and Ruth have also started helping 8 children schooling in Taunggyi from this year. Therefore, there are totally 23 children under the care of TCC. Of them, only 5 children have sponsor the rest are in need of much help. According to the present inflation rate, child will need \$30 per month. It can cover both food and tuition fees.
